

How to install WP Responsive Photo Gallery into your WordPress site or blog ?

1. Just login to your website admin panel.

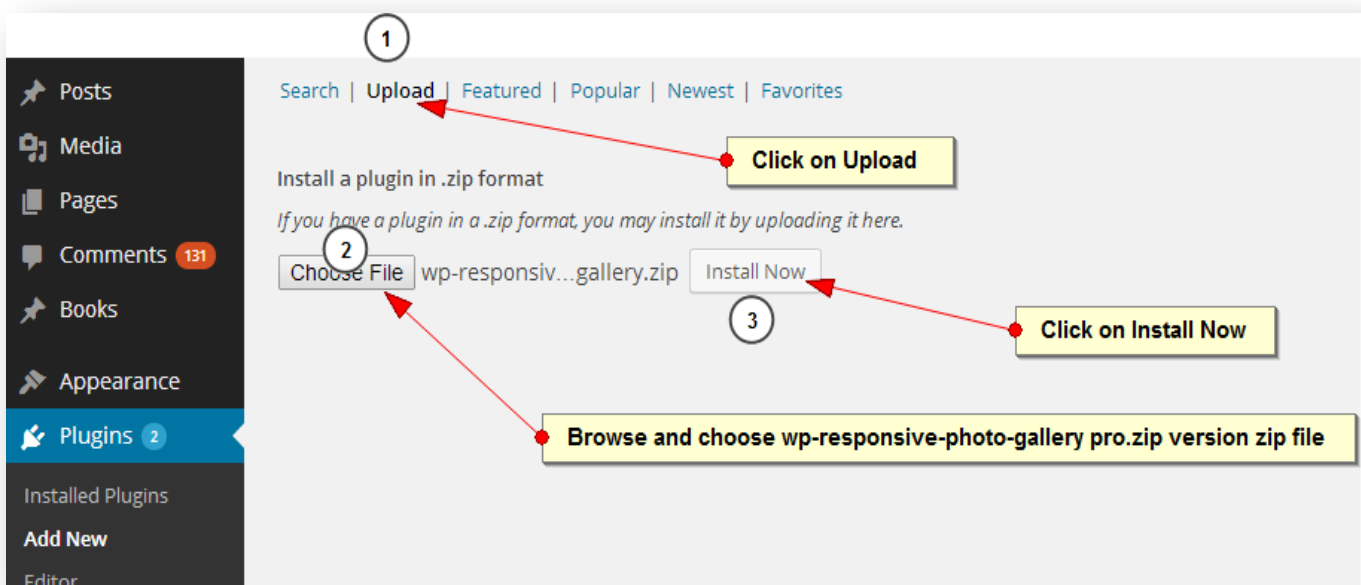

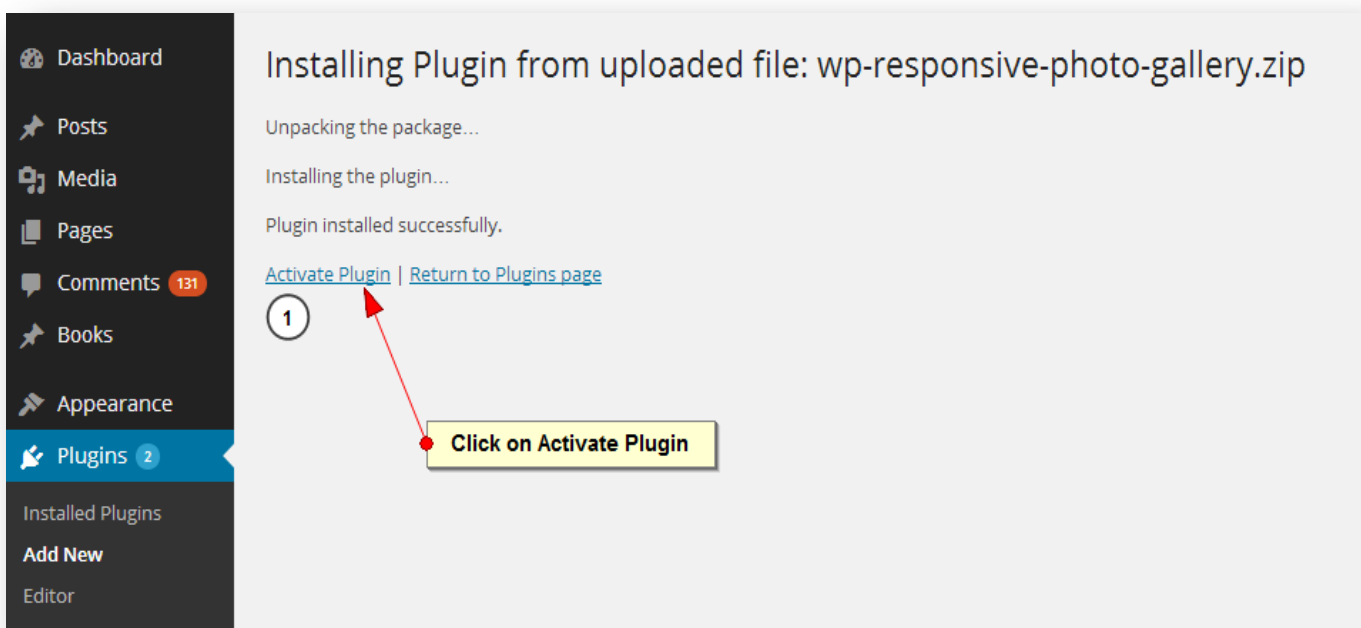

5. Activate Plugin

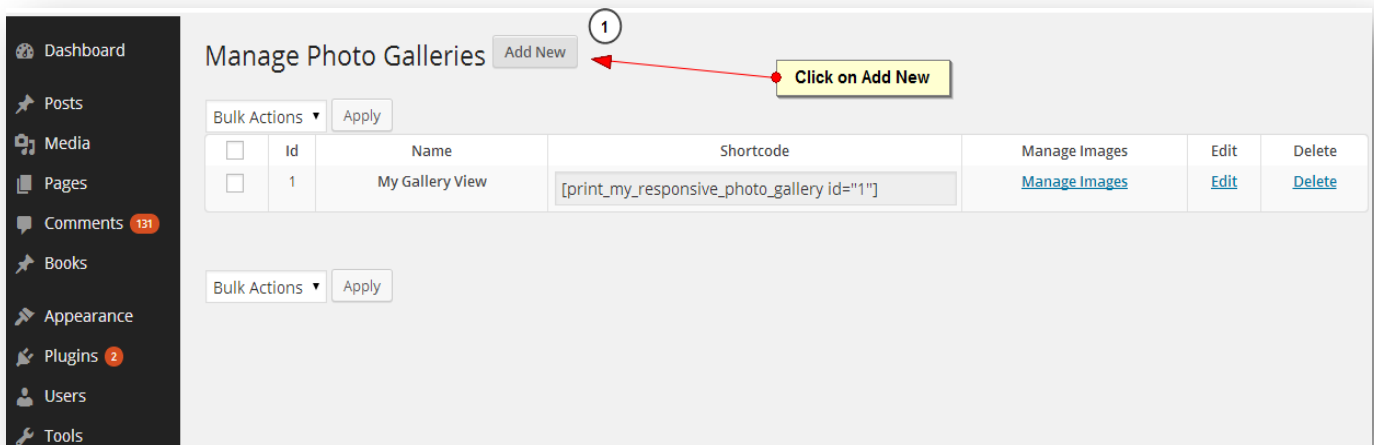


How to add new Responsive Photo Gallery + Slider?

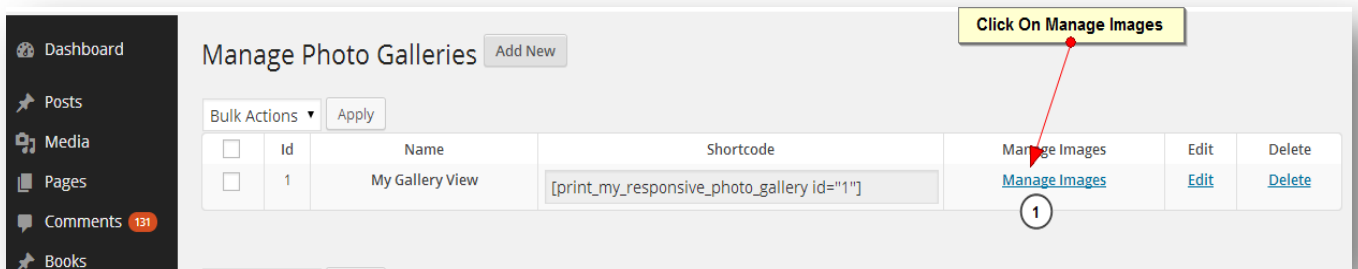

2. Click on “Manage Images” against the photo gallery you would like to add images.







3. Click on "Add New" button.

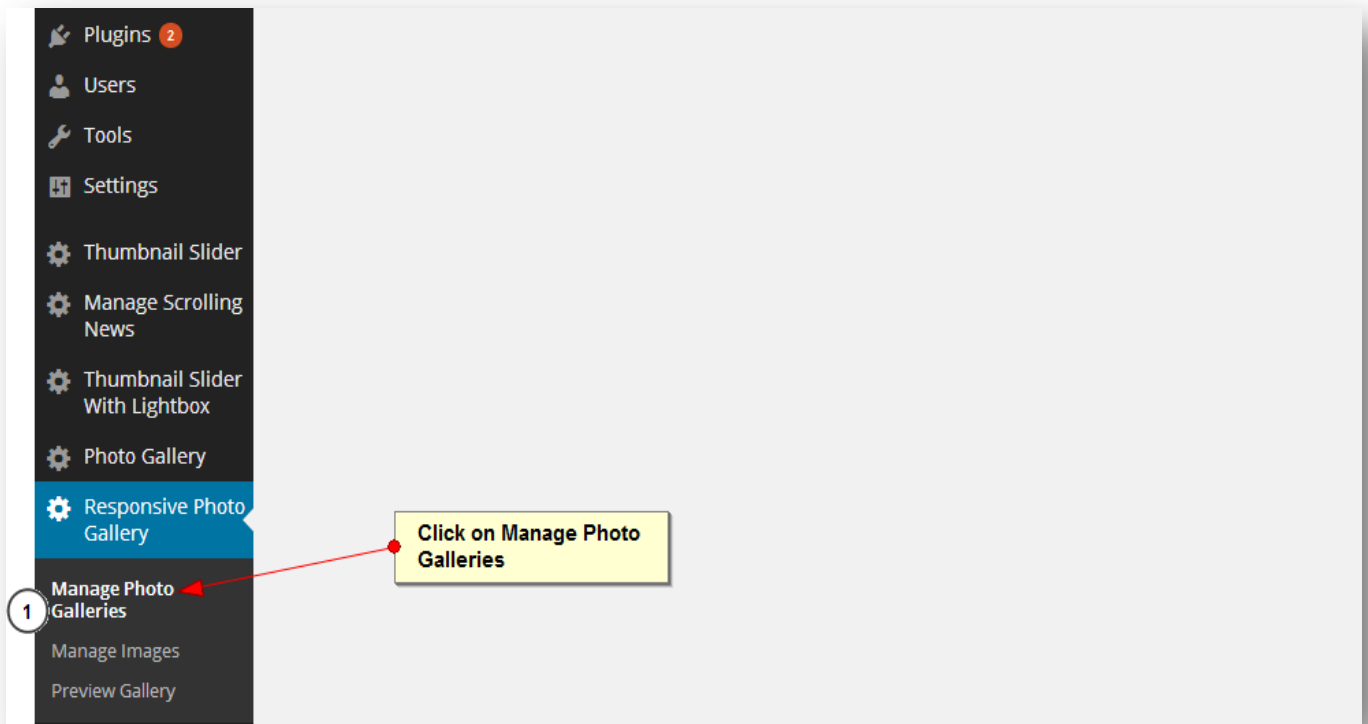

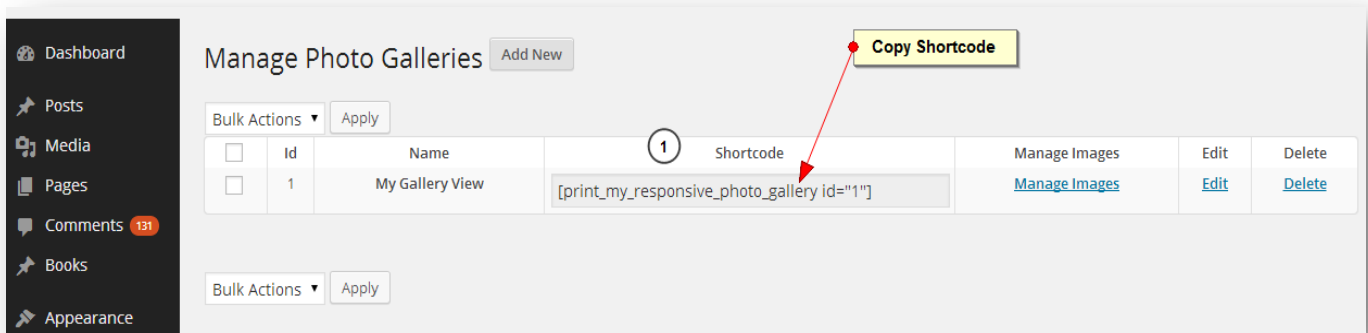

2. Copy Shortcode of gallery you would like to print into post or page



3. Go to page or post you would like to have responsive gallery. Open page or post into edit mode and paste shortcode.
