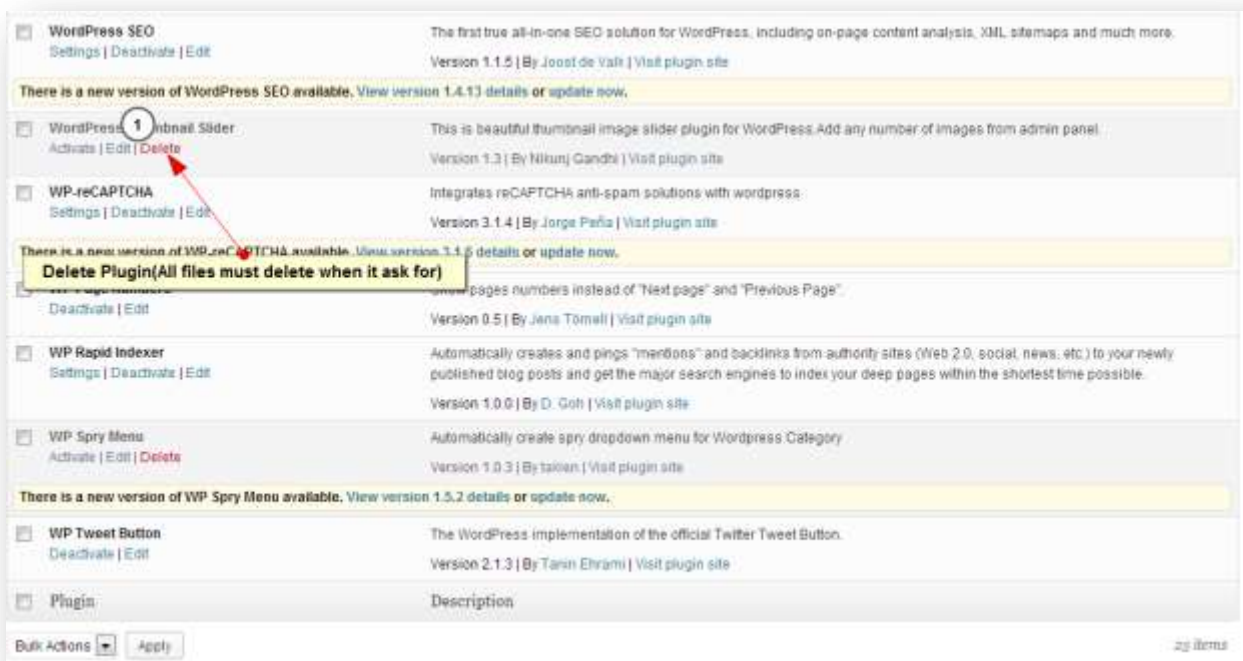

How to install responsive thumbnail slider into your WordPress site or blog ?

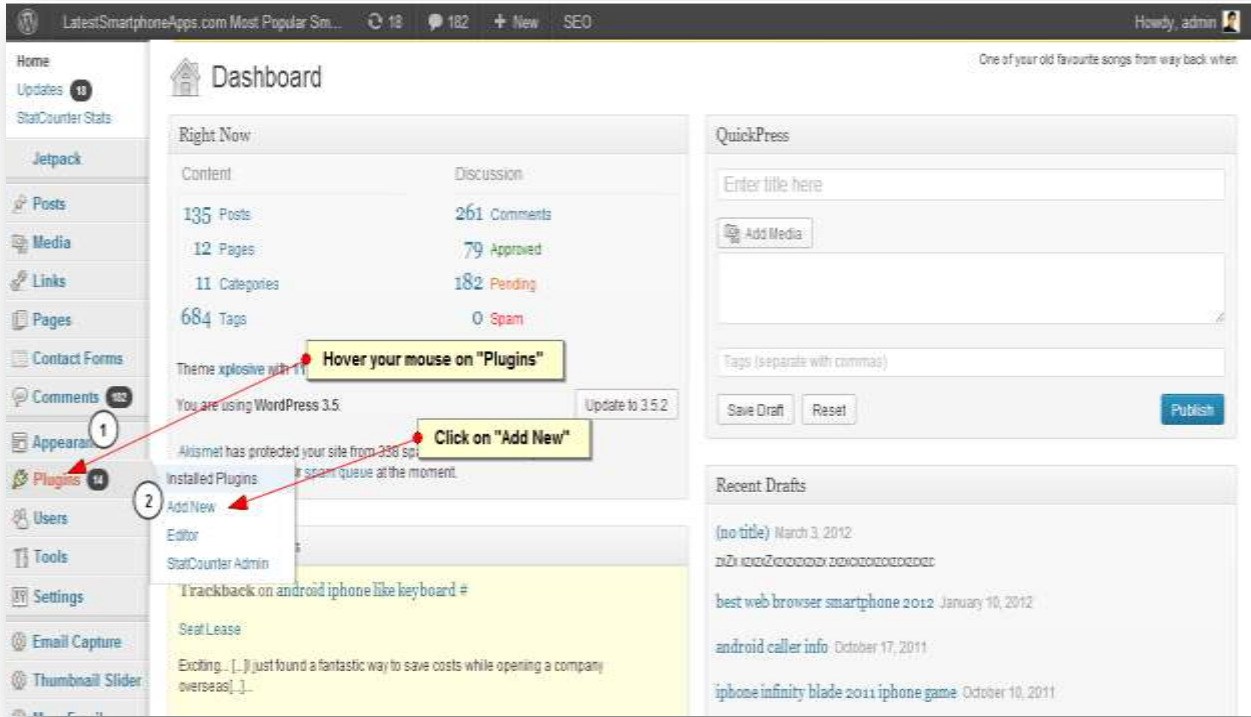
1. Just login to your website admin panel.



2. If you have installed free version of thumbnail slider then first you need to delete this plugin. Go to plugin management screen and deactivate plugin and delete it.



3. Now Add **pro version** Go to Menu. Hover your mouse on "Plugins" and click on "Add New"



4. Click on "Upload" Select plugin zip file called "wp-responsive-thumbnail-slider.zip" and click on Install Now.

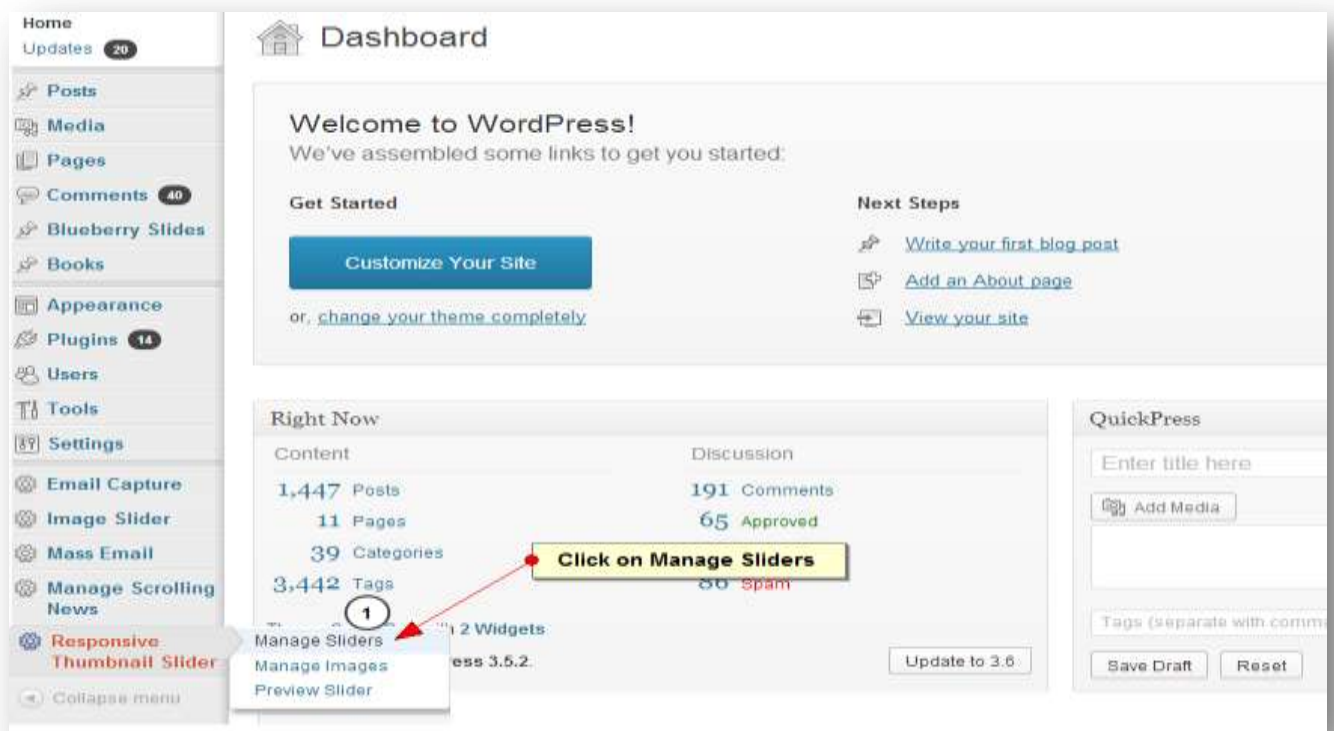


5. Activate Plugin

How to add responsive thumbnail slider into fronted?

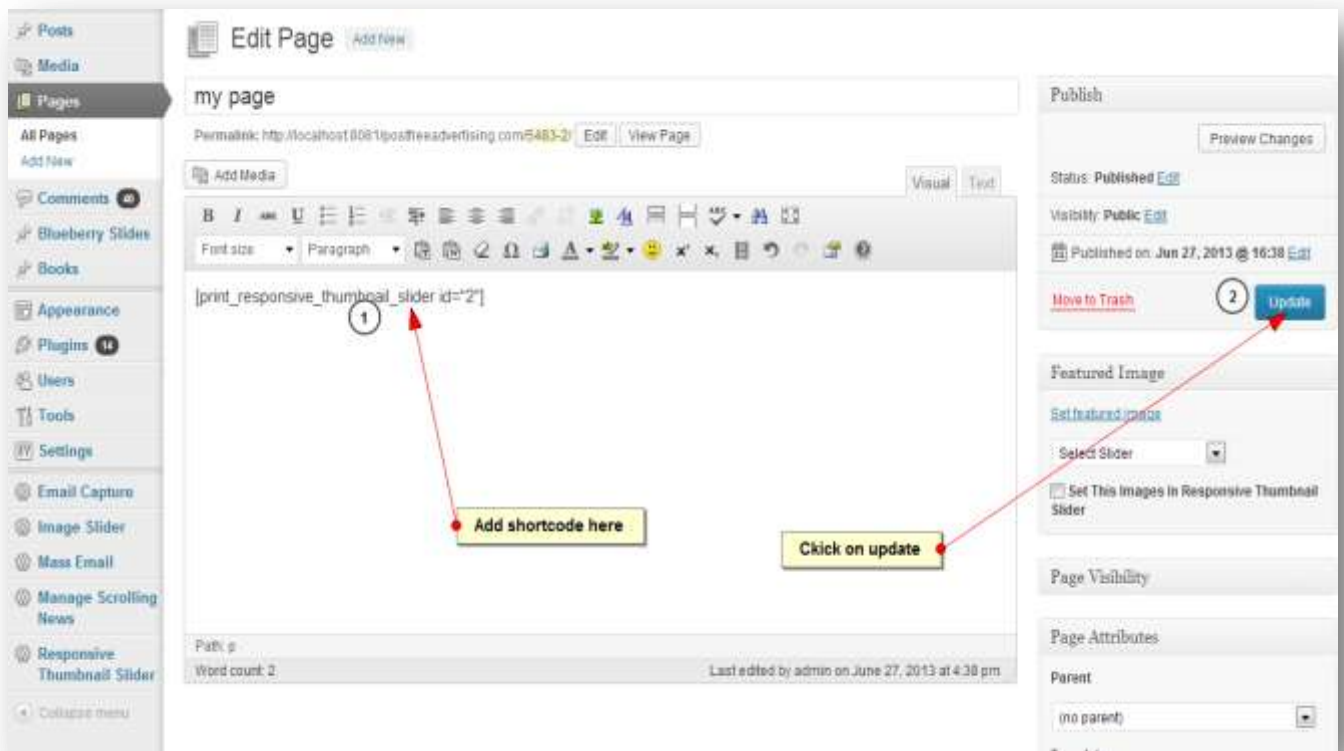
1. After login to admin panel. At bottom there is menu called "Thumbnail Slider" click on "Manage Sliders".



2. Copy Shortcode of slider you would like to print into post or page



3. Go to page or post you would like to have slider. Open page or post into edit mode and paste shortcode.
