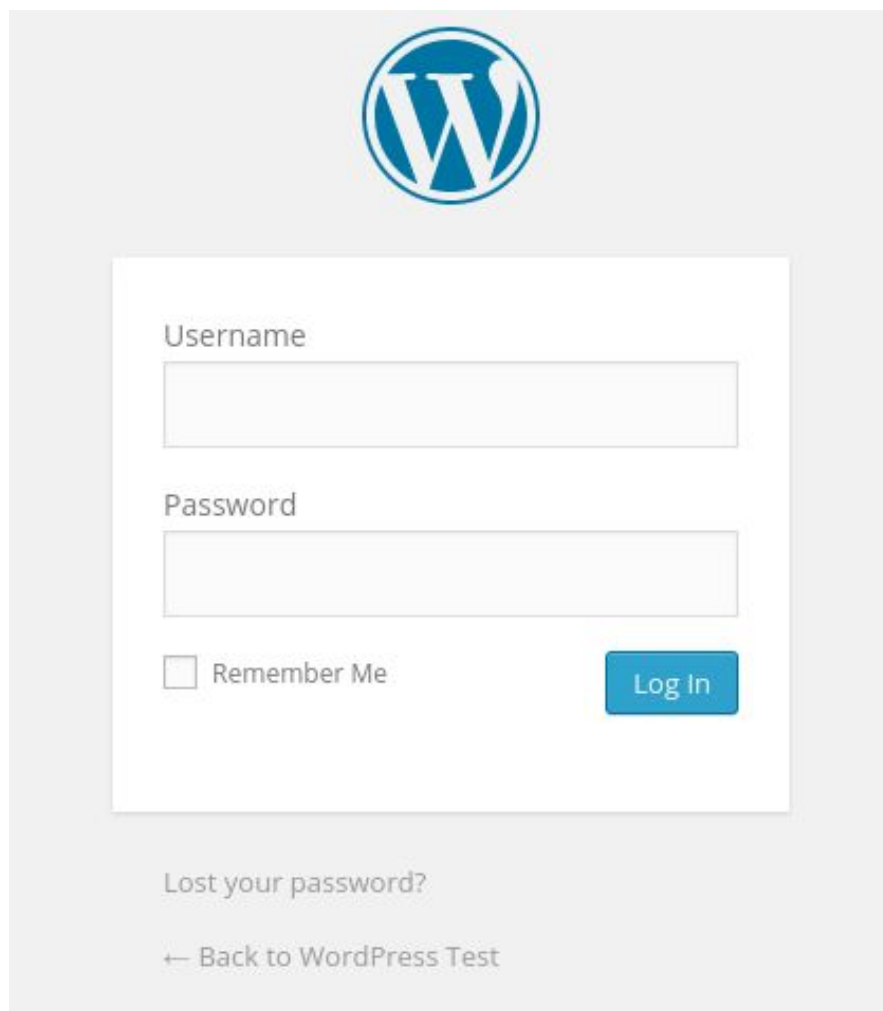

1. Just login to your website admin panel.



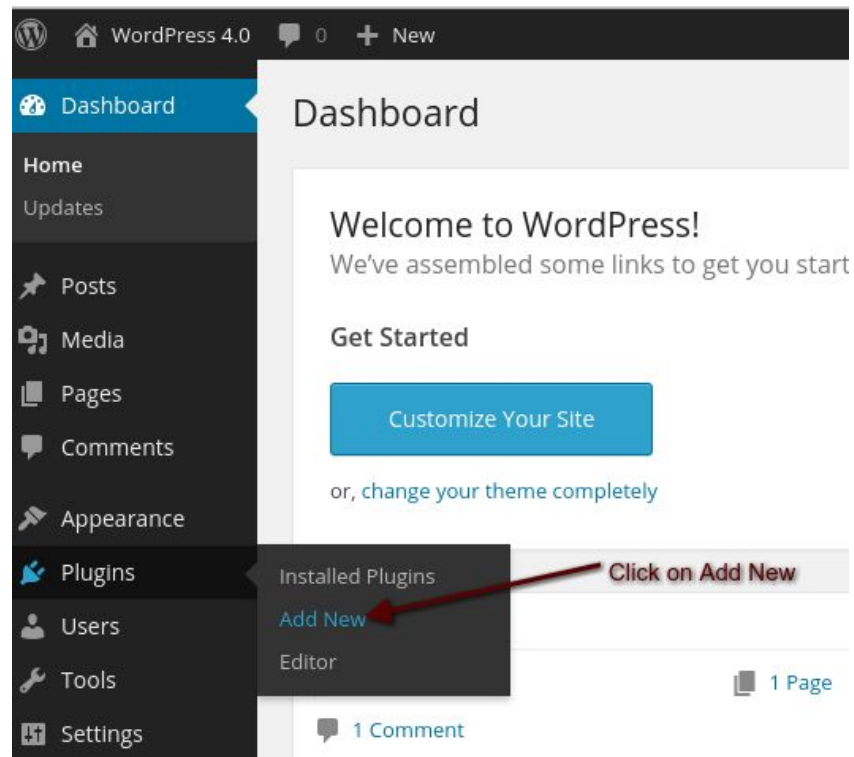
2. If you have installed free version of slider then first you need to delete this plugin. Go to plugin management screen and deactivate plugin and delete it.

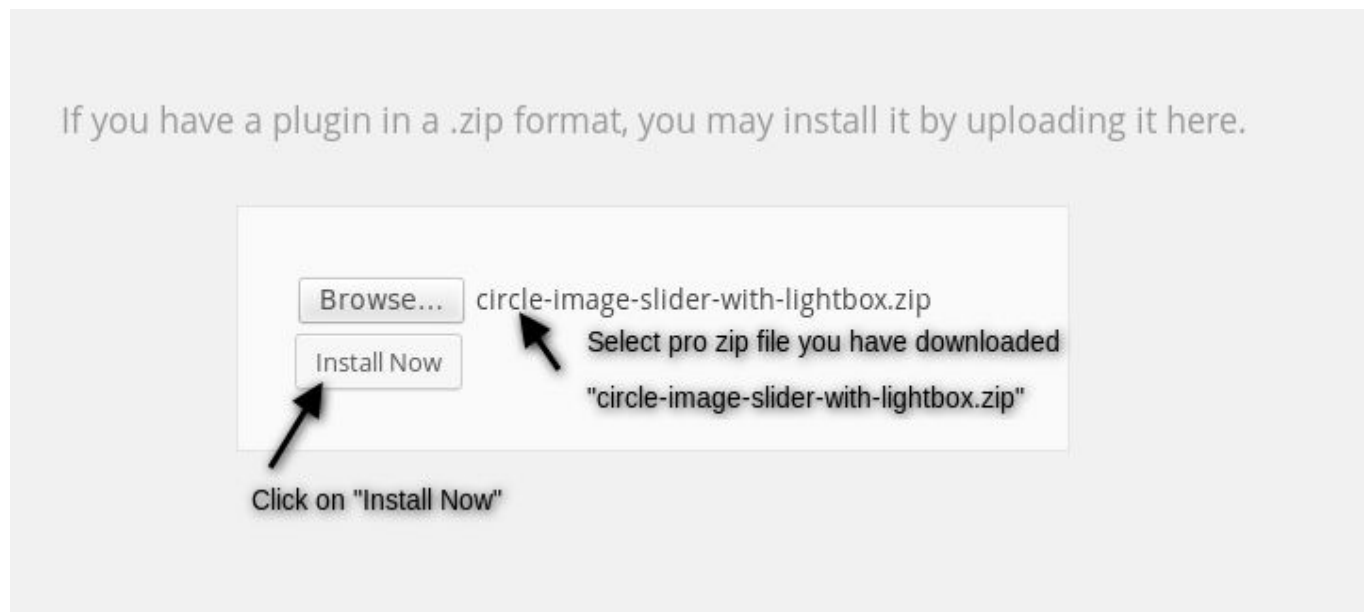

4. Click on "Upload" Select plugin zip file called "circle-image-slider-with-lightbox.zip" and click on Install Now.

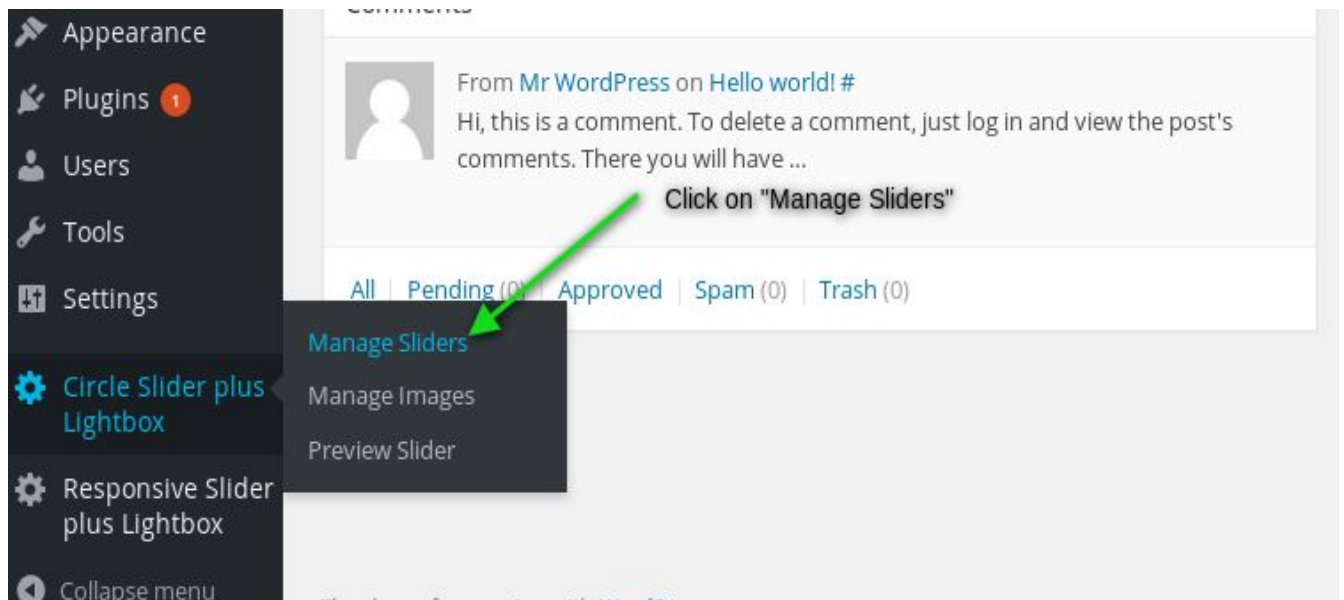
