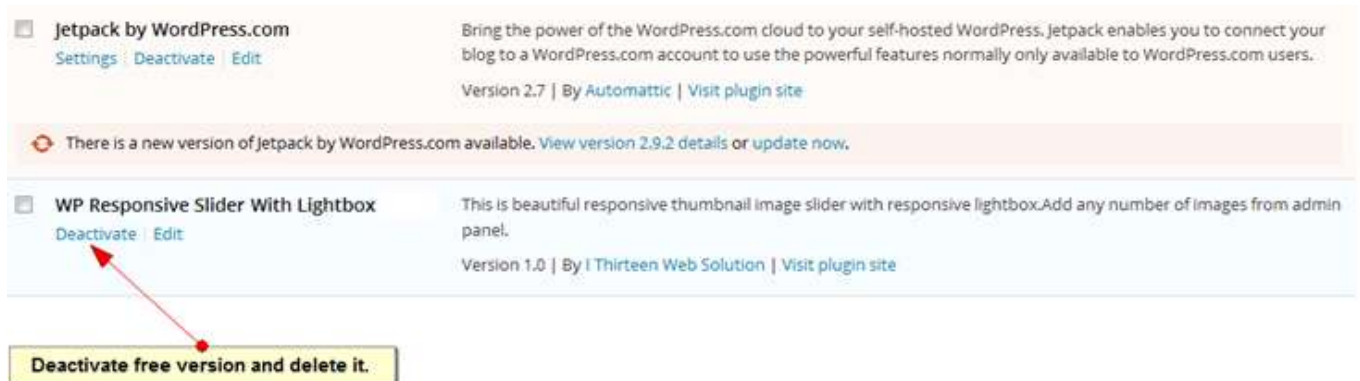
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## How to install responsive slider with lightbox into your WordPress site or blog ?

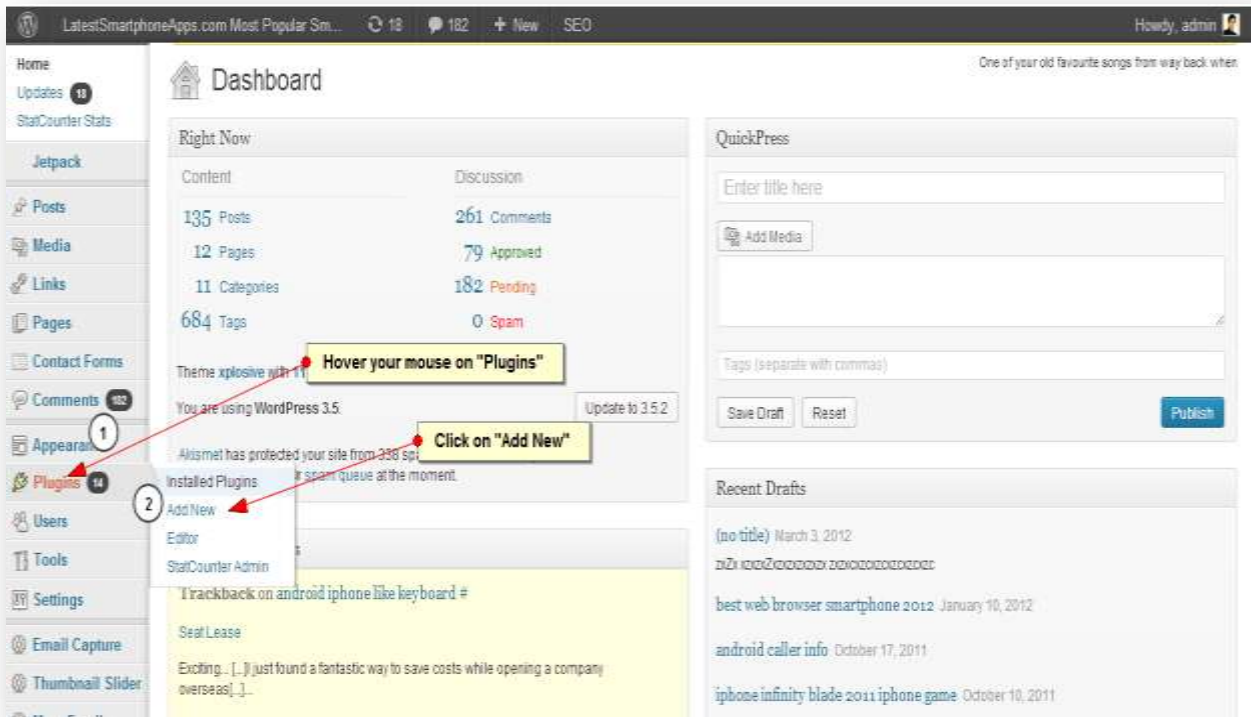
1. Just login to your website admin panel.



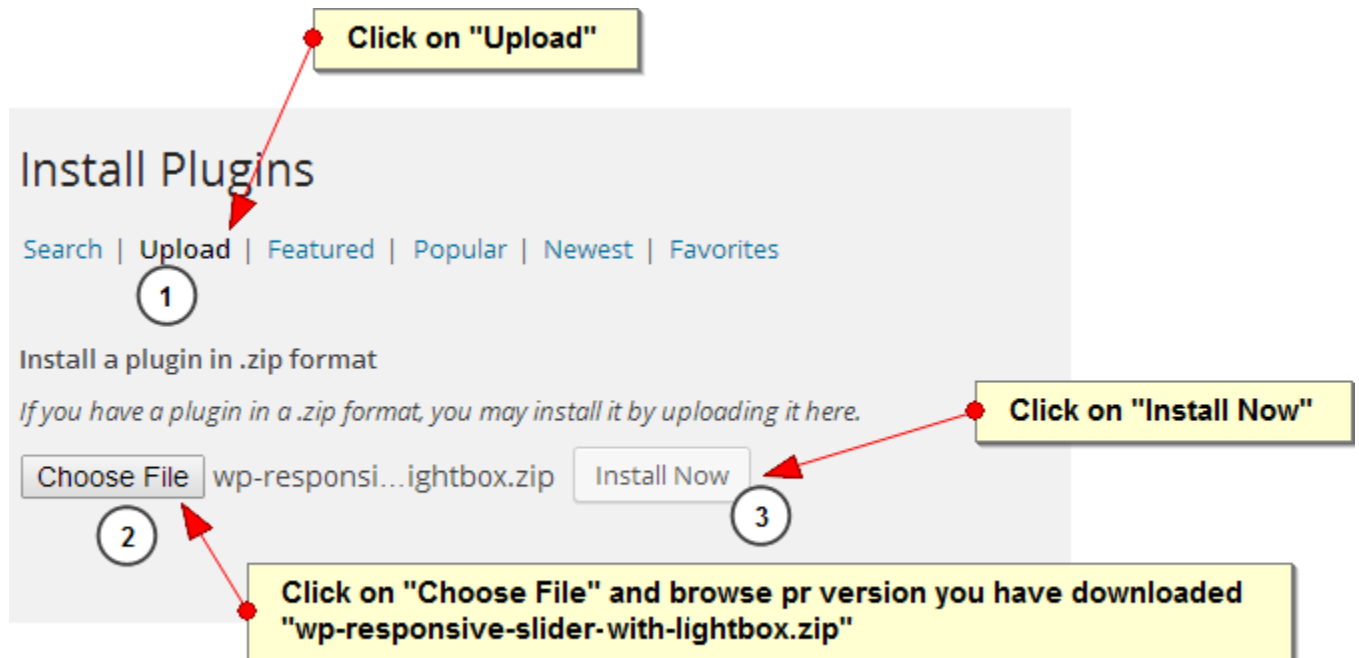
2. If you have installed free version of slider then first you need to delete this plugin. Go to plugin management screen and deactivate plugin and delete it.



3. Now Add **pro version** Go to Menu. Hover your mouse on "Plugins" and click on "Add New"



4. Click on "Upload" Select plugin zip file called "wp-responsive-slider-with-lightbox.zip" and click on Install Now.



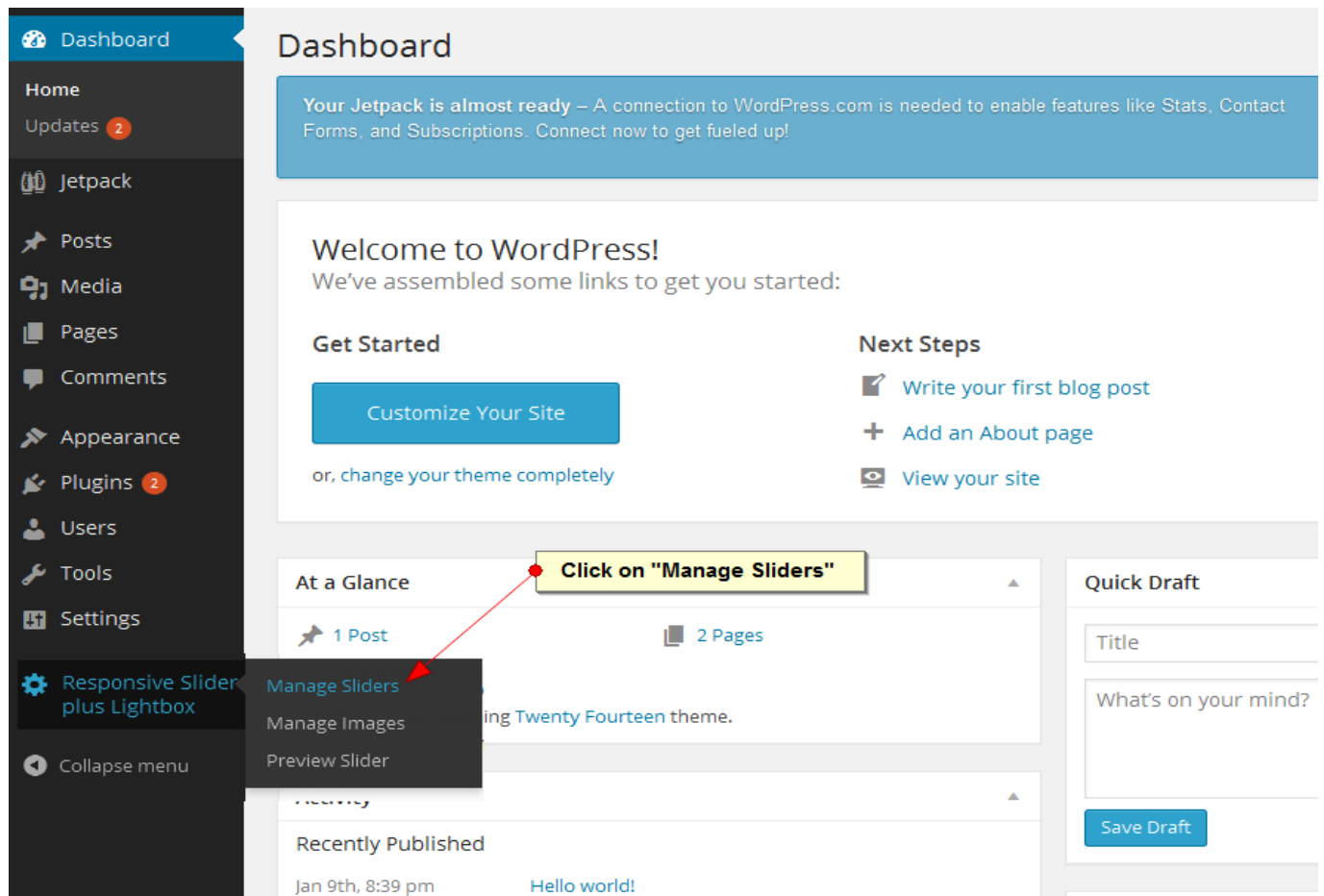

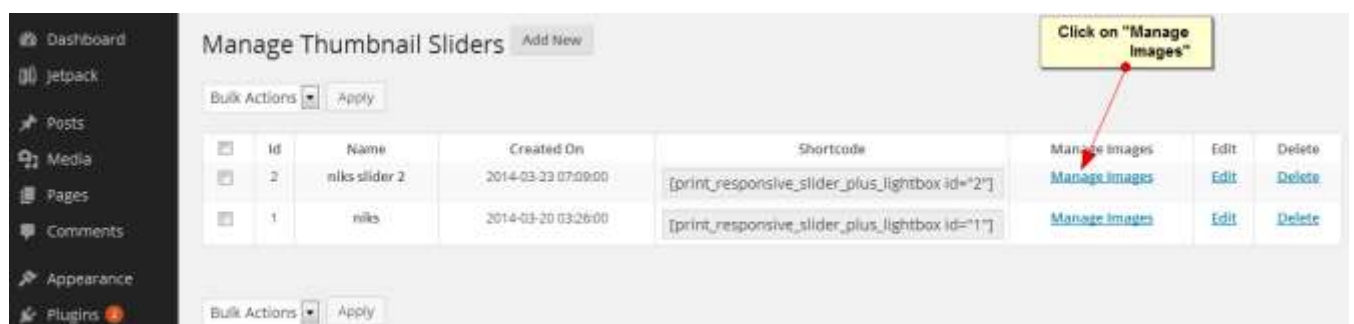
